If You Saw Hungry Children Everyday, Would You Buy Them Lunch?

Thousands of children in our area will be facing hunger this summer. Kids receiving free/reduced meals during the school year often suffer malnutrition and do not have enough food in summertime, seriously impacting their physical and mental health. When school gets out there is a sudden increased need for food in households already experiencing poverty, creating a hunger crisis in the summer for families in our area.

The Attleboro Area Council of Churches Kids Summer Café program combats childhood hunger by providing children a healthy lunch when school is not in session. Free, bagged lunches are distributed three times a week at four local playgrounds in Attleboro. We will be serving lunch Tuesdays, Wednesdays & Thursdays from July 5th - Aug. 18th from noon – 1pm.

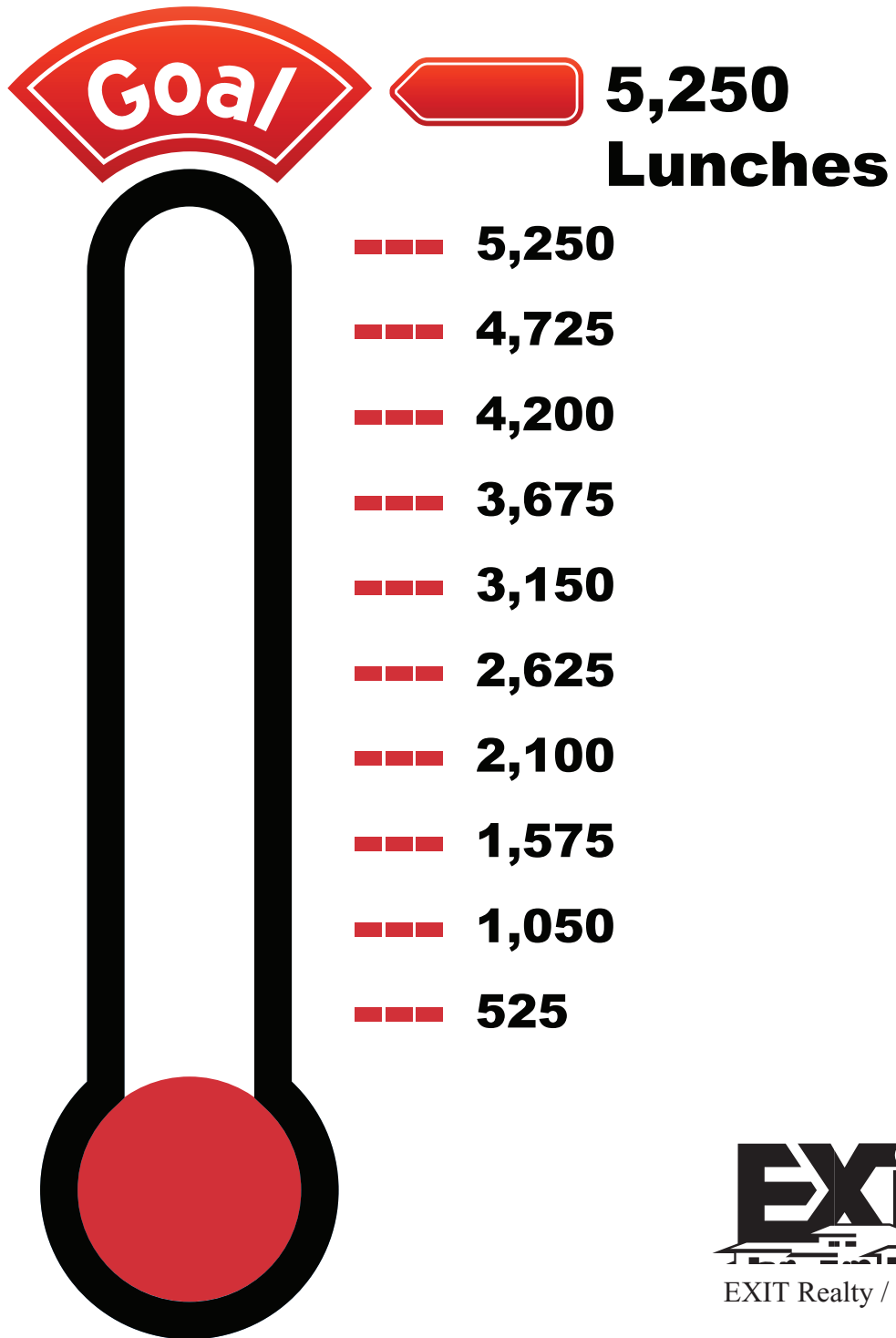
